A bit of history.

ULB and VUB have common roots:



Pierre-Théodore Verhaegen

1834: Creation of the "Université Libre de Belgique" by Theodore Verhaegen (Nov. 20th)

1842: "Université Libre de Belgique" renamed "Université Libre de Bruxelles"

1890: First courses in Dutch in the Faculty of Law


1963: All faculties offer courses in Dutch / are bilingual



1969: Belgium starts its evolution towards a federal state

ULB and VUB become separate universities,

Birth of the "Vrije Universiteit Brussel", with full programs in Dutch





2011: VUB and ULB Engineering Faculties introduce joint 4 Masters (double degree):

Architectural Engineering, Civil Engineering, Chemical and Material Engineering, Electromechanical Engineering

2012 : VUB and ULB introduce joint Master in Electrical Engineering

2016 : First 5 interregional Joint Master Degrees

2019: First joint graduate ceremony

Today:

Classes on both campuses, by professors from both universities Classes are mixed with Dutch, French and English-speaking students Joint degree from two universities ca 200 graduates every year








Each of you has a main affiliation at ULB or VUB

Check your schedule (times and rooms) each week, for instance on Sunday evening







A student must have a mark of a minimum of 10/20 to pass a course.

At the exam session where you can graduate, limited failure can be tolerated, with the following constraints:

- Have a weighted average of at least 55%
- Have failed no more than two courses
- Have maximum three 'failed' marks (eg. 9/20 and 9/20, or 9/20 and 8/20, or 9/20, or 8/20, or 7/20)
- Have passed the master's thesis
