

## **Additional provisions to the ULB General Study Regulations (BRUFACE)**

In accordance with point f) of the introductory provisions of the General Study Regulations 2025-2026, adopted by the Academic Council on 3 July 2025, the faculties may define specific optional provisions to the present regulations, which exclusively specify articles 48, 74, 75, 81, 93, 94 and 102 of these regulations.

In the context of course programmes co-organised with the VUB (Bruface), a number of specific additional provisions are set out in the co-organisation agreement. They are available on the website <https://bruface.eu/>

All students enrolled in these programmes are subject to these regulations.

**Art 48** : Master thesis are governed by specific regulations, which are made available to the students concerned.

**Art 74** : The closing date for the open assessment of the second session is 31 October at the latest.

**Art 75** : A scanned copy of the medical certificate must be sent by e-mail to the Faculty secretariat (polytech@ulb.be).

**Art 81** : The appeals body is the Appeals Committee. It is composed annually by the Special Committee of the Ecole polytechnique de Bruxelles (ULB) (4 full academic members, including the Dean). It is chaired by the Dean of the the Ecole polytechnique de Bruxelles (ULB)  
For students enrolled in a Bruface master's degree, the Appeals Committee includes members of the VUB academic body

**Art 93** : Grades are given according to the following rules: summa cum laude (with highest honors) 85%, magna cum laude (with great honors) 77%, cum laude (with honors) 68%. In case of 'acceptable deficit', the jury must vote for the grade by simple majority

**Art 94** : The weighting of each course is defined by its number of ECTS. If a mark is not available at the time of deliberation, the assessment may be neutralised and replaced by the weighted average of the student's results.

**Art 102** All appeals will be dealt with by the Appeals Committee of the Ecole Polytechnique de Bruxelles (ULB). Appeals must be sent by e-mail, duly substantiated, to the Dean of the Ecole Polytechnique de Bruxelles (ULB)., as Chair of the Appeals Committee.  
An acknowledgement of receipt will be sent to the applicant for appeals lodged.
